Description:

To oversee the staging area and secure/store individual racers' personal effects, wheelchairs, prosthetics, mobility devices tools and other equipment as needed in provided trailer. Additionally, this volunteer will ensure that equipment is retrieved only by authorized persons. All training and materials will be provided.

Key responsibilities and accountabilities:

1. Keep record of equipment in/out of trailer using tags and clipboard.
2. Be willing to move mobility equipment and personnel effects in/out of trailer.
3. Be comfortable restricting access to equipment and ensuring that only authorized persons have access to equipment in secure storage area.
4. Retrieve equipment and personal effects from trailer upon request of the owners.
5. Assist with setup and tear down of race at beginning / end of each event.
