



Job Type: Cycle Racing Volunteer – **Timer**

Positions Available: 2

Duration: 6 weeks, Tuesday's 6:00 – 9:00 pm, June 12 – July 17

Location: Cuddy Park Skating Oval - Anchorage Alaska

Organization: Challenge Alaska

Description:

The timers will start the race clock and maintain control of timing device throughout the race. The timers will keep an accurate record of the number of laps each racer completes. At the designated time the timers will ring the bell (as provided by the race director) informing the racers that upon crossing the finish line their race is complete. The timers will then record the actual time for each racer as they cross the finishing line for the final time as well as the number of laps. This information will be recorded into a prepared Excel spreadsheet using a provided laptop. The spreadsheet will calculate the adjusted time for the racers and the timers will then print the results to be given to the Registration table for racers to see their final standings for that race.

Key responsibilities and accountabilities:

1. Start the race clock at the beginning of each race
2. Accurately record the number of laps each racer completes in each race
3. Identify when the final lap (bell lap) is to be announced and ring the bell to notify racers
4. Record the final time for each racer after the bell lap and their total lap count
5. Enter the information into an Excel Spreadsheet and print the results to be given to the Registration table.
6. Assist with setup and tear down of timer area at beginning / end of each event.
