



Job Type: Para-Cycling Rider

Description:

To ride with 1-4 individuals during scheduled weekly cycling rides, using your own bike or one of Challenge Alaska's adaptive cycles (subject to availability).

Key responsibilities and accountabilities:

1. Ability and willingness to provide basic support for para-cyclists in the event of a basic mechanical incident (chain coming loose, flat tire, etc – training provided upon request with advance notice)
2. Ability and willingness to help load/unload equipment prior to and at conclusion of rides.
3. Must wear ANSI/SNELL approved cycle helmet at all times using any type cycle.
4. Ability to contact Challenge Alaska staff (cell phone) should an incident occur that you are unable to assist with due to lack of knowledge, training, safety concerns, etc.
5. Basic first aid / CPR knowledge
