Description:

To ski prepare and maintain cross country skis and sit ski frames for regular use prior to and during the cross country ski season. Initial season preparation (October) is the most labor intensive. After the initial season preparation is complete times and dates for ongoing maintenance can be flexible (1x ever 1-2 weeks).

Key responsibilities and accountabilities:

1. Ability to perform basic skills essential for cross country ski maintenance.
 - A. Hot waxing – includes safe operation of hot iron that will reach temperatures of up to 270 degrees and use of wax.
 - B. Scraping
 - C. Brushing – includes use of power drill facilitated roto-brushing.

2. Experience welcome but not required as training will be provided in all aspects of ski maintenance and safe use of equipment.
