

Challenge Alaska COVID-19 Programming General Procedures:

- Reserve a spot ahead of time for yourself and anyone planning to attend with you, to remain within group size limits.
- Arrive on time with equipment in good working order. If equipment needs attention, it may affect your ability to participate that evening.
- Upon arrival and check in, all participants will be pre-screened using questions listed below:
 - Travel inside or outside Alaska in the past 14 days?
 - Have fever, cough, respiratory issues?
 - Have any other symptoms of COVID?
 - Have you been tested for COVID? If so, what was the result?
- Cloth face coverings must be worn by all members of the group, including family and friends riding with any member of the group, as recommended by the CDC throughout the ride.
- Maintain 6 foot spacing with non-household members, at the trailhead pre/post event as well as on the trail.
- Not share water bottles with anyone outside your household.
- Participants are strongly recommended to ride in pairs or as small a group as possible.
- At conclusion of program, participants should depart the activity area as timely as possible.
- Please be aware that public restrooms and port-a-potties may be closed. Please plan accordingly.

Challenge Alaska will provide and make available upon request:

- Bottled water
- Sunscreen (spray on)
- Insect repellent (spray on)
- Nitrile gloves
- Hand sanitizer
- Trash bag
- Basic First Aid Kit / Supplies

Challenge Alaska Equipment Protocols:

- Wipe down all high use parts of equipment as well as any areas with visible stains
- Equipment will be sprayed with industrial sanitizer following each use and allowed to air dry
